Free Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Summer Program



Citrus County School District plans to hold the Summer VPK Program June 3rd through July 24th at Pleasant Grove Elementary School. School will be held 4 days a week, 7:15 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Daily attendance during scheduled instruction is of utmost importance for your child to remain in the program.

Applications may be acquired at any elementary school.

- You must get a **Certificate of Eligibility (COE)** for VPK from the Early Learning Coalition (ELC) of the Nature Coast, 352-563-9939 x 0. Remember, your child must be "4" as of September 1, 2023.
- To attend Summer VPK **you must register** your child for Kindergarten at their zoned school!

Transportation is NOT provided for Summer Voluntary Prekindergarten program.

Kindergarten Roundup

Thursday, April 25th is early registration day for kindergarten students entering school for the 2024-2025 school year. Registration will be from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m..

Children must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2024 for kindergarten.



Parents are reminded to bring the following:

- child's birth certificate (Must be a vital statistic certificate)
- social security card
- certificate of immunization (Florida Blue Card)
- proof of current physical examination by a medical doctor or from the health department (Must be within the year before school starts)
- Two proofs of Florida residency (i.e. bill with your name & address, house rental or lease contract, etc.)

2024-2025 Fall Pre-Kindergarten Program



Pre-kindergarten classes are available in Citrus County Schools and at Private Child Care

Providers through out the County. To participate in any of the classes, including the IPS Pre-K program, a Certificate of Eligibility is required by the State of Florida. **Children must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2024 for the prekindergarten 2024-2025 program.**

For Citrus County Schools information, applications may be acquired at any elementary school or contact the District Office at (352) 726-1931.

For information on Private Voluntary Pre-kindergarten Providers and to obtain a **Certificate of Eligibility (COE)** which is required to enroll a child into the program, you must contact Early Learning Coalition (ELC) of the Nature Coast, (352) 563-9939 x 0.

F.A.S.T. TESTING IS COMING!

The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.) is the progress monitoring assessment tool that is aligned to the Benchmarks for Excellence Student Thinking (B.E.S.T) Standards. We do not want the F.A.S.T. to be a stressful situation for our students. This is just an opportunity for students to show what they have been taught and have learned this school year.

Parent letters will come home with your child closer to the assessment window, which provides more information about the third and final F.A.S.T. assessment for the 2023-2024 school year. Listed below are the dates of the 3rd testing window for the F.A.S.T. assessments for each grade level. These dates are just the testing window; the specific dates for each grade level will be included in the F.A.S.T. parent letter that will go home closer to the testing window.

Here's how you can help your student to do his/her best:

- **Make sure your child is at school every day and is here on time..**
- **Check your student's work and review nightly assignments.**
- **Stay connected with your child's teacher, especially if your child is having difficulties.**
- **Read to your child or make sure your child reads independently each night.**
- **Ensure students are practicing fact fluency nightly/ weekly.**
